

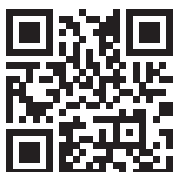
Ceramin® floors are among the highest performing floors available. To ensure your floors will look as good as the day they were installed, follow the simple instructions outlined below so you can enjoy them for years to come. KEY CARE AND MAINTENANCE CRITERIA

- It is recommended to place floor mats and area rugs at main entrances to minimize abrasive debris that may be introduced to the floor.
- It is recommended to place protective pads under furniture legs and other movable furniture to minimize potential scratching and abrasive scuffs.
- It is recommended as a best practice to use protective mats under wheeled office-type chairs to reduce/prevent traffic patterns.
- In cases of wheel chair use take care to remove embedded debris from tires when entering the home and use protective mats under high use areas.
- Avoid using polishes, waxes or detergent-based cleaners as they will leave a film/residue on the surface of your floors and may cause damage beyond repair. The surface of Ceramin® flooring does not require refinishing and will maintain its original appearance.
- Never use abrasive cleaners on your Ceramin® floors.
- We do not recommend flooding or heavy use of water on your floor. While Ceramin® is a waterproof product, over time moisture can seep through the seams of the floor and cause moisture related damage underneath the floor.

DAILY CLEANING GUIDELINES

- For daily cleaning, use a dust mop, broom or vacuum with hard surface attachment to remove dust, loose dirt or debris.
- The use of residential steam mops is allowed if used at lowest power setting with a suitable soft pad. The steam cleaner should be moved along the floor in even strokes. Holding a steam mop on one spot for an extended period of time should be avoided. Refer to the steam mop's manufacturer instructions for proper.
- To apply cleaner to the floor we recommend using a misting bottle, applying the cleaner to an area and then wiping with a cloth or mop.
